In 2013, the Chapter formally established an Aquatic Education/TIC Classroom Support Grant. These grants are available to Idaho K-12 teachers to assist them in their aquatic education efforts. This may include the Trout-in-the-Classroom program or other aquatic education efforts. The number of grants awarded annually is dependent on available funding and need.

Grant Amount: \$50-1250

Eligibility: Any Idaho K-12 classroom
